PLEASE WAIVE ALL SIGNATURE REQUIREMENTS ON OVERNIGHT DELIVERIES

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club, or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC, ILP or PAL number. Bitches in season, aggressive, blind or deaf dogs or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance are ineligible to participate. Mixed breed dogs that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form and the trial-giving club is offering the optional mixed breed classes.

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. They will adhere as closely as possible to the Judging Schedule. The owner or handler of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when its class is to be judged. The trial giving club and the Trial Secretary have no obligation or responsibility for locating dogs that are not at ringside when required.

At the handler's option, dogs may wear flat buckle or quick snap collars, but there shall be no hanging tags or attachments. Choke, pinch, electric, or dummy collars are prohibited.

All dogs must be on leash and in control at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated warm-up area. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dog(s), children, & guest(s). Any exhibitor whose dog(s), children, or guest(s) create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the Trial site. In such case, no refund of fees paid will be made.

All regulations governing the use of this facility and all regulations and decisions of the Trial Committee of this trial-giving club on these days will be strictly enforced.

Exhibitors and handlers will be held responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates and parking areas. Dogs may be exercised **ONLY** in designated areas. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their own dogs **AT ALL TIMES**. Dogs will not be allowed in restrooms. No dogs are allowed overnight at the Trial site. Puppies under 6 months of age are strictly prohibited from the grounds.

NOTE ON CRATING: There is very little shade at the site so competitors may want to bring a shade tent.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Members of the Chaparral Kennel Club (CKC), Cloudcroft High School, their agents, employees, etc., assume no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or their dogs, or property and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

No entry fees will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.

CKC may decline any entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness or other cause, and no one shall have any claim or recourse against CKC or any official thereof.

Safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering this Trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the Rules & Regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all of the obstacles safely.

Entries must reach the Trial Secretary by Wednesday, June 30, 2010, 6 P.M. (MT) or when 330 entries for Standard & Jumpers With Weaves Classes per day have been reached. Fees must accompany all entries. Exhibitors are responsible for complete, accurate and legible information on their entry forms. Post dated checks and returned checks will invalidate an entry with a \$25 Service Fee charged for returned checks. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee. Bitches in season are not allowed at the Trial. Entry fees for bitches that come into season after these Trials have closed will be refunded, less fees per day for Judge & Secretary fees (Handler must provide a vet certificate) provided the Trial Secretary receives notice in writing on or before Thursday, July 15 2:00 p.m. (MT). Telephoned & unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC Entry Forms or photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules are not acceptable. No entry shall be made and no entry accepted which specifies any conditions to its acceptance.

Entries cannot be accepted, cancelled, altered or substituted after the entries have closed except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules. Changes, additions or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing prior to the close of entries. Those received by phone are not acceptable. Long distance calls for information on this Trial will be returned **COLLECT**. Calls may be accepted from 9AM to 9PM (MST) **ONLY**. There is no refund for duplicate entries. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

COURSE SIZE AND SURFACE

The rings and crating area are outdoors. The course surface is grass.

There will be two rings with one judge.

The course size is approximately 100' x 100' feet.

COURSE FAMILIARIZATION & WARM-UPS

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, prior to the start of the class. A walk-through period will be held prior to each class, following the Judge's Briefing.

As per AKC regulations, there will be **NO** Novice familiarization.

A warm-up area consisting of a single regulation agility jump shall be provided.

MOVE-UPS

Dogs may be moved to a higher class at the request of the owner as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that the request is made to the Trial Secretary, **no later than Monday, July 12, 2010, 6:00 p.m. MT for the Saturday Trial and by the end of the trial on Friday or Saturday for the Saturday or Sunday Trial.** Dogs so moved will be entered at the end of the running order. **Move-ups may be sent in writing or e-mailed to the Trial Secretary.** The e-mail move-up will not be official unless acknowledged by the secretary. A form is enclosed for your convenience.

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

MEASURING and HEIGHT CARD INFORMATION

Effective January 1, 2010, exhibitors are no longer required to provide proof to Trial Secretaries that their dog has a valid jump height card as part of the check-in process. Furthermore, this change eliminates the need for a copy of the jump height card to be submitted with an entry form. Dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form may still compete; but they must be measured/wicketed by the **Judge of Record** PRIOR to running in their class and this measurement will be valid for that weekend of trials only. The exception to this requirement is a dog entered in the 24" or 26" height division. However, if a **Volunteer Measuring Official (VMO)** or an **Agility Field Rep** is present; **ALL** dogs without a valid Jump Height Card/Form must be measured at some time during the trial or cluster of trials. This does not preclude having the dog wicketed by the Judge of Record if the VMO or Rep is not available to measure the dog *before* its first run of the trial or cluster of trials. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog measured prior to running and failure to do so will result in the cancellation of any qualifying scores.

NEW Simplified Jump Height Card Process

When filling out the entry form, there is a new section at the top of the form for exhibitors to designate whether your dog has a valid jump height card or if your dog needs to be measured. Please check the appropriate box so that the Trial Secretary knows whether to include your dog on the *Dogs To Be Measured List*. It is no longer required that you submit a copy of your dog's jump height card with your entry form or show it during day of show check-in.

HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Owners are responsible for entering the proper height division. Judges reserve the right to measure dogs entered in any Trial. In traditional agility, dogs may, at the handler's option, be entered in a higher height division, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. In Preferred dogs must run in the division appropriate to their height. Dogs that run in a height division lower than their proper division will be eliminated.

CLASS INFORMATION

Handlers have the option of entering dogs in either the Regular classes or the new Preferred classes. On any given weekend, only one of these programs (up to 4 classes per dog) may be entered.

Regular Classes – Standard and Jumpers With Weaves (JWW)

Novice Agility & Novice JWW Classes – The Novice Agility Class and the Novice JWW Class are divided into Divisions A and B. Division A is for dogs that have never acquired any AKC Agility title. Additionally, a dog entered in Novice A must be handled by a person that has never put an AKC Agility title on any dog, and the handler must be the Owner, Co-owner, or a member of the Owner's household. Division B is for dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility (NA) title, or the Novice JWW (NAJ) title, or for persons who have handled a dog to any AKC Agility title, and for dogs being handled by someone other than the Owner, Co-owner, or household member. A dog may continue to be shown in the Novice B Class until they have acquired a qualifying score towards their Open title.

Open Agility Class – Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility (NA) or Open Agility (OA) titles but which have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Agility Excellent (AX) title.

Open JWW Class – Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice JWW (NAJ) or the Open JWW (OAJ) titles but have not acquired a qualifying score towards an Excellent JWW (AXJ) title.

Agility Excellent "A" Class – Open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility (OA) title, and to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent (AX) title but that have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Agility Excellent (MX) title.

Excellent JWW "A" Class – Open to dogs that have acquired the Open JWW (OAJ) title and to dogs that have acquired the Excellent JWW (AXJ) title but have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Excellent JWW (MXJ) title.

Master Agility Excellent "B" Class – Open only to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent (AX) title, and to dogs that have acquired the Master Agility Excellent (MX) title.

Master Excellent JWW "B" Class – Open only to dogs that have acquired the

Excellent JWW (AXJ) title and to dogs that have acquired the Master Excellent JWW (MXJ) title.

Preferred Classes – Standard and Jumpers With Weaves (JWW)

All dogs entering the Preferred Classes for the first time must enter the Novice level regardless of their previous title level in the Regular Classes (Standard and JWW). There is no grandfathering of titles from the Regular Classes to the Preferred Classes or from the Preferred Classes to the Regular Classes.

Novice Agility & Novice JWW Preferred Classes – The Novice Agility Preferred Class and the Novice JWW Preferred Class are not divided into Divisions A & B. These are the entry-level classes for dogs starting in the Preferred program (even if they have acquired upper level titles in the regular classes).

Open Agility Preferred Class – Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice Agility Preferred (NAP) title or Open Agility Preferred (OAP) titles but that have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards their Agility Excellent Preferred (AXP) title.

Open JWW Preferred Class – Open to dogs that have acquired the Novice JWW Preferred title (NJP) or Open JWW Preferred (OJP) titles but that have not yet acquired a qualifying score towards their Excellent JWW Preferred (AJP) title.

Agility Excellent "A" Preferred Class – Open to dogs that have acquired the Open Agility Preferred (OAP) title, and to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent Preferred (AXP) title but that have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Agility Excellent Preferred (MXP) title.

Excellent "A" JWW Preferred Class – Open to dogs that have acquired the Open JWW Preferred (OJP) title and to dogs that have acquired the Excellent JWW Preferred (AJP) title but have not acquired a qualifying score towards their Master Excellent JWW Preferred (MJP) title.

Master Agility Excellent "B" Preferred Class – Open only to dogs that have acquired the Agility Excellent Preferred (AXP) title and to dogs that have acquired the Master Agility Excellent Preferred (MXP) title.

Master Excellent "B" JWW Preferred Class – Open only to dogs that have acquired the Excellent JWW Preferred (AJP) title and to dogs that have acquired the Master Excellent JWW Preferred (MJP) title

OBSTACLES

Obstacles will conform to the requirements in the current edition (Sept. 1, 2006) of the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials.

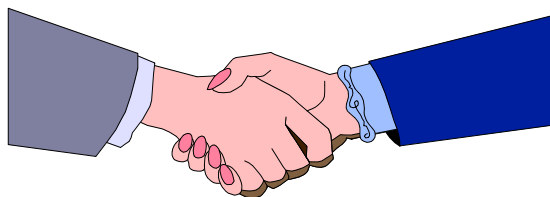
